Police ticketing targets WWU students

■ \$20 fines given for cars parked more than 24 hours

BELLINGHAM – The Bellingham Police Department has stepped up its parking enforcement this week, issuing dozens of tickets along Garden, Indian and 21st streets.

On 21st Street, nearly every second car along several city blocks was issued a violation. Traffic Sgt. David Richards said the department has upped issuing violations in the last two weeks due to the presence of a fourth parking enforcer, who returned to duty on Jan. 1.

Richards agreed that “most” of the ticketing was done near the Western Washington University (WWU) campus, and said the target areas probably had “more students that parked there

Judged by a group of their peers

■ Not for determining guilt or innocence, Teen Court determines punishment

COUNTY – One Wednesday evening each month, the cases of four juvenile offenders are heard in Whatcom County District Court.

When walking into the third-floor courtrooms of the Whatcom County Courthouse on those dates, things look fairly normal, except for one glaring

difference: The judge, the jury, the attorneys for both the defense and the prosecution, the clerks, and even the bailiff – are all high school students.

These students are charged with running every aspect of each trial, from swearing in those who testify, to presenting arguments, to reaching verdicts, to pronouncing sentences.

Whatcom County's Teen Court, which has been up and running since 1998, was the first of its kind in Washington State and is often used as a model by other communities trying to start their own.

Whatcom County Superior Court Judge Charles Snyder said it all started when he read an article about a similar concept in Texas. He soon

Jenni Potts live

"I believed what you said when you were lying on top of me"

Never having seen Potts perform live, I can't describe the experience. But something about her music makes me suspect that it's best suited to a live performance in a small, intimate venue. Listening to her music at home on a stereo seems somehow antiseptic. As I listen to what she's singing, I want to see the person, her expressions as she sings, and how she reacts to the audience.

Potts said her personality on stage doesn't match up with the feel of her songs.

"I'm really social with the audience, but my songs are kind of sad," she said.

She describes her interaction with the audience as alternating between "bubbly" and making the audience laugh.

"I do like playing live more than anything in the whole world," she said. "I just feel more myself and more calm on stage."

"I don't know how it happened, but somehow it turned into lust"

At times in her music, some hope peeks out from under the layers of melancholy. There is a love for life under the surface. She wants things to work out, and she can reach out to other people, hoping to find some trust there.

"What happened to you?" she sings in her song "Friends." "You used to love me."

Potts said about two-and-a-half years ago a friend took a copy of a demo she had made and gave it to Clickpop Records without telling her. It turned out they were interested, and since then she's been touring and will soon be releasing a full-length album.

Bellingham-based singer-songwriter Jenni Potts isn't shy about putting herself into her music. Her song lyrics take what's going on inside her, no matter how painful, and send it out for anyone to hear.

At age 20, Potts has found an outlet in her music. Maybe the youthful angst goes into her lyrics now and stays there, where it can be enjoyed by her audience rather than suffered through alone.

"Sure, I sing like an angel, but I ain't got no wings"

What is most prominent on her EP, titled *The Fourth*, is her voice. She said that her vocal style acts as a counterpoint to the pain in her lyrics.



"I usually get inspired by painful things happening to me," she said. "But since my songs sound pretty, I think people can listen to them and kind of be at peace about it."

You can hear the pain in her voice as she sings; she's like a wounded bird. Her voice is a plaintive wail that evokes a feeling that is less peaceful than it is haunting.

Her songs aren't an attack, though. It doesn't feel as though she is lashing out in anger, or trying to inflict her pain on others. Instead, she's letting the audience inside so they can observe and empathize.

Special Mentshn

Mentshn It!, by Millie and the Mentshn, is a terrific album, in fact, it is downright addictive.

It's klezmer music, mostly salvaged from the former Jewish enclaves of Eastern Europe obliterated in the Holocaust.

The Fiddler finally fell from the roof, still playing. But when that swinging beat starts to pick up speed, a vanished community springs to life and invites us to join the dance. Our feet take on a life of their own and we have no choice but to come along for the ride.

The "Mentshn" (Yiddish for "guys") are a four-man combo and they're fine players. But this is Millie Johnson's show. Her soprano voice is as fresh and clear as spring water, and she is a master musician and an enchanting storyteller.

The songs bear on their back a great sack of grief, yet they

are never maudlin. Just reading the dates of the composers and poets (1916-1943, 1916-1945) breaks your heart. Johnson has elected not to weep, but to celebrate and to witness.

Working from bare sketches, she has used simple means to craft loving arrangements of great skill and imagination. It's hard to imagine a more spell-

garian rhapsody, sum up the allure of the music:

*When you hear it, it seems so simple,
And you have no idea
How deeply it moves the soul...
You want to hold on forever
To the strains of the melody.*

At the heart of the album are two songs as haunting as Schubert's "Lieder."

Both poets, a man and a woman, were partisan fighters. She was captured and executed by the Gestapo at age 26. He survived and lives in Israel at age 96.

His poem, entitled "Under Your White Stare," is a cry from out of the depths. Her's, "Birds Dozing," is a lullaby, sung by Death to an orphaned infant. Both melodies are wreathed in Ms. Johnson's beautifully wrought counterpoint.

These songs are separated and surrounded by rousing, strategically placed instrumental dances.

There is even a Yiddish tango, played and sung to the hilt, followed by the anthem of the Depression, "Brother, Can You Spare a Dime?" commemorating America's own Diaspora back in the Dust Bowl days. It's in English, delivered in the

binding interpreter.

This is no mere anthology; it has great bone structure.

The album is bookended by two songs written as vehicles for the legendary Molly Picon, queen of the Second Avenue Yiddish theatre on Manhattan's Lower East Side. The first one introduces the performers. The lyrics of the last, a kind of Hun-

loose-gaited, swinging style of Sinatra. The rest of the songs are sung in Yiddish.

bent figure eight, enclosing the motto, "Fun Dor Tsu Dor," meaning, "From Generation to Generation." That expression suggests both continuity and a gift. This album succeeds brilliantly on both counts.

Millie and the Mentshn is one of five American klezmer ensembles invited to play at the First International Klez Fiesta in Buenos Aires this September. Sales of *Mentshn It!* will help finance the trip and the rest will be raised in a double-header concert with their larger parent band, What the Chelm, at the Fairhaven College Auditorium on March 8. Both the CD and concert tickets are available at Village Books. ■WI
